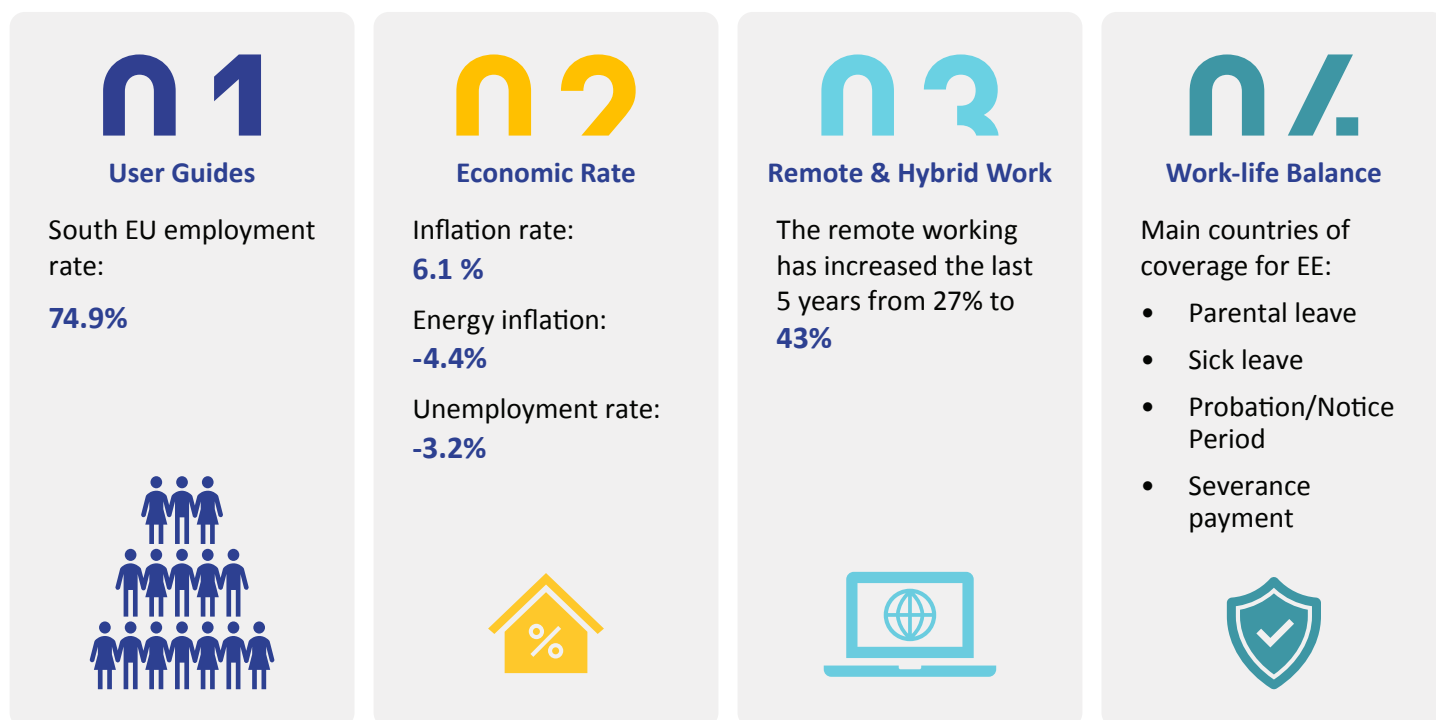
- Spain is **divided in Autonomous Communities**, that have a certain level of self-government.

- ESP: 24% flat income tax rate for 5 years for max 499,999,00€

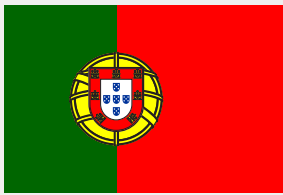
New Measures Approved in 2024

Spain



- Increase in the Minimum Interprofessional Salary
- Reduction of working hours to 38.5 hours per week
- Regulation of scholarship holders ← scholarship holder statute
- Possible extension of parental leave to 20 weeks.

Portugal



- Increase in the Minimum Interprofessional Salary to 821,23
- Occupational accident pensions increase by 6% in 2024
- The 3-day waiting period for medical leave will be waived if medically justified under oath.
